- Spartanburg Medical Center (SMC), a 540-bed research and teaching hospital

- Pelham Medical Center in Greer, S.C., a 48-bed, acute-care facility, with an emergency center, medical office building
- Union Medical Center, formerly Wallace Thomson Hospital, a 143-bed hospital in Union, S.C., with emergency services, inpatient/observation care and outpatient diagnostics
- Ellen Sagar Nursing Center in Union, S.C., a 113-bed long-term care facility offering skilled nursing and rehabilitation services
