

FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

Eligibility for financial assistance is based on the U.S. Government's Federal Poverty Guidelines. These guidelines are updated each year.

You may qualify for financial assistance if your income is less than or equal to 2 times (200%) of current Federal Poverty Guidelines.

You may qualify for partial financial assistance, depending upon your household income and the number of members in your family. This is also based on the U.S. Government's Federal Poverty Guidelines.
